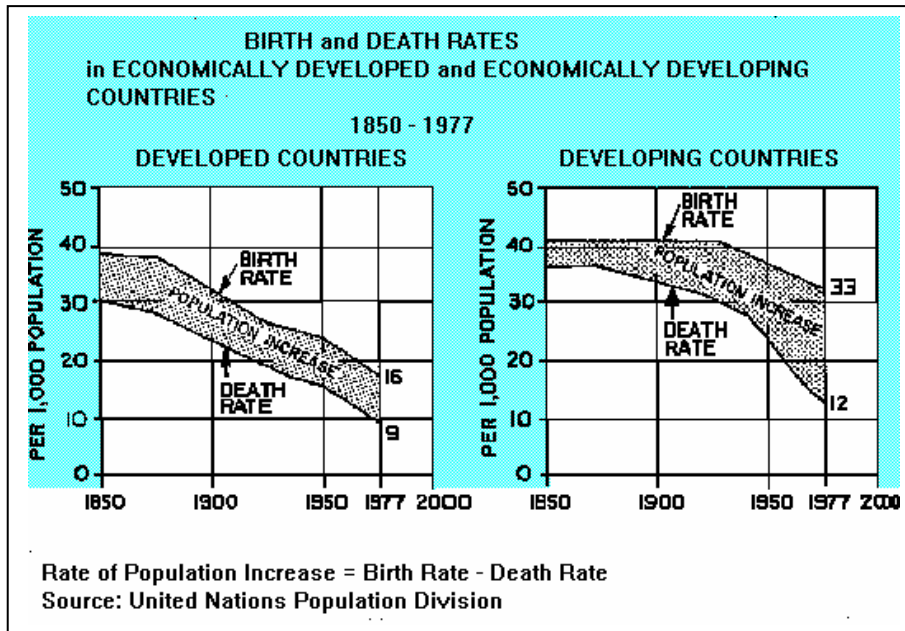

5) UNIVERSAL DECLARATION OF HUMAN RIGHTS

Article 2: Everyone is entitled to all the rights and freedoms set forth in this declaration, without distinction of any kind, such as.. color, sex, language... nations or social origins, property, birth or other status

Article 5: No one shall be subjected to torture or to cruel, inhuman or degrading treatment or punishment.

Article 9: No one shall be subjected to arbitrary arrest, detention or exile.

Article 13: Everyone has the right to leave any country, including his own, and to return to his country.

Article 18: Everyone has the right to freedom of thought, conscience and religion...

Article 20: Everyone has the right to freedom of peaceful assemble and association.

Article 21: Everyone has the right to take part in the government of his country, directly or through freely chosen representation.
